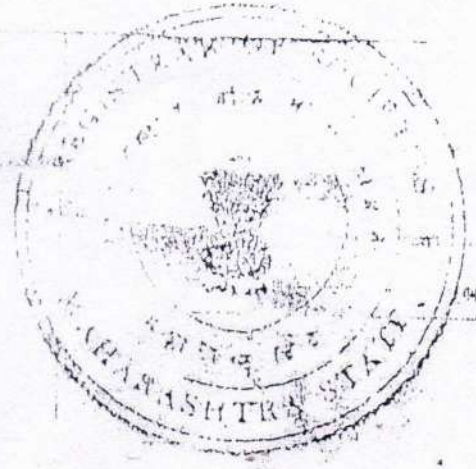



- 3) Further, MARBISM was also in receipt of the complaint against your institute and accordingly assessment report along with the complaint was placed in the 134th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 16.07.2025. On careful examination of the assessment report, Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college and same was communicated to you vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 05.08.2025 to appear on 08.08.2025 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the permission to your college be denied for the academic session 2025-26
- 4) The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated in the hearing letter. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide letter. No BMAM/4113/2025 dated 07.08.2025 against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives Hearing was attended by Dr. Yuvraj Kale, Principal & Superintendent of the college appeared before the Hearing Committee on 08.08.2025 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. 

ID-AYU0170) is hereby granted with yearly permission with an intake capacity of 100 seats in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and in accordance with Regulation 15 (7) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 with 23 seats in 09 PG Course in the subject namely- (1) Ayurveda Samhita, Sanskrit and Siddhant - 04 seats (2) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (3) Kriya Sharir - 02 seats (4) Dravyaguna Vigyan - 01 seats (5) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana - 04 seats (6) Swasthavritta & yoga - 03 seats (7) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka - 03 seats (8) Kaumarbhritya - Bala Roga - 02 seats (9) Kayachikitsa - 01 seats for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled: -

Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 23 seats in 09 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

- 7) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 8) Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the

concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

- 9) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10) **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 11) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for Postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024
 - iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for the Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - v) The remaining visitation fee as communicated in letter dated 28.01.2025.
- 12) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am directed to refer to your application vide dated **31.08.2020** forwarded by GOI vide letter No. **L-14013/07/2020-EP (1) Dated 29.09.2020**, on the subject cited above and to say that physical verification of available facilities of teaching and practical training **to increase intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats from the academic session 2021-22**. Therefore, as per direction of competent authority on the basis of Part-I visitation proforma submitted by **Bhau Saheb Mulak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Great Nag Road, Nandanwan, Distt. Nagpur-440009, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0170)** as well as indemnity bond, affidavit & details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the said college were examined and vide Medical Assessment and Rating Board letter ref. no 3-3/2021-Ay.(31) Dated 24.09.2021, LOI (letter of Intent) has been issued to your college **to increase intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats from the academic session 2021-22**.

2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the institution on **26.10.2021** for Letter of

Permission (LoP) and 13C to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training for conducting UG & PG course and to verify the compliance of shortcomings informed by the NCISM under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.

3. Further, On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on **06.12.2021** to present the case through virtual mode.
4. On examining the same it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria for Issuing Letter of Permission (LoP) **to increase in intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats**, for the Academic Session 2021-22 onward.
5. Further vide commission letter ref no. **3-3/2021-Ay. (31). dated 07.12.2021** letter has been sent to the college to furnish fixed security deposit worth rupees 50 Lakhs in favour of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine, in response of the same college has furnished the fixed security deposit in favour of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine through RTGS/NEFT/UTR. **No. PUNBR52021120817278578 dated 08.12.2021 of rupees 50 Lakhs transferred by PNB Bank (for a period of five years).**
6. Further, in view of above, the college has been assessed on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the Ministry of AYUSH and on examining in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criteria **to increase in intake capacity of UG (BAMS) course & Granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course and 09 PG courses for A.Y. 2021-22.**
7. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) to issue Letter of Permission (LoP) to the **Principal, Bhau Saheb Mulak Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Great Nag Road, Nandanwan, Distt. Nagpur-440009, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0170)** to **increase in intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats from the academic session 2021-22 under Section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and grant conditional Permission for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 23 seats in 09 PG courses namely:- (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (ii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (iii) Kriya Sharir-02 seats (iv) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-04 seats (v) Dravyaguna-01 seat (vi) Agad Tantra-03 seats (vii) Kaumarbhritya-02 seats (viii) Kayachikitsa-01 seat and (ix) Swasthavritta-03 seats** for the academic session 2021-22 under section 28/29 of the NCISM 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions:
 - I. The conditions as specified in the Undertaking/Indemnity bond submitted by the college.
 - II. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of the letter, explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying fee same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
8. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG (BAMS) seats and 15% of 23 PG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2021-22 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2021 to get permission for the session 2022-23:
- all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
12. This permission to increase in intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2021-22 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020.
13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2022-23.

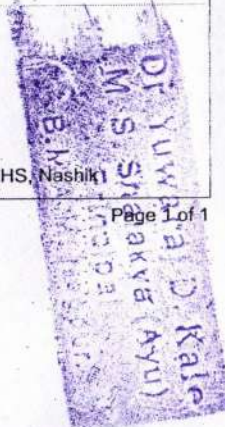
